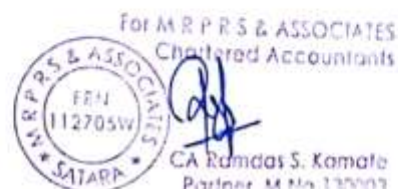

दलित साहित्याची प्रेरणा ही डॉ.बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर, म.फुले, संत घोखामेळा, बुध्द, कबीर, किसन फागुजी बनसोडे यांच्या सारख्या महात्म्यांनी दलित समाजासाठी मोलाचे कार्य केले. आपल्या साहित्याच्या माध्यमातून अन्याय, अत्याचार, वेदना, व्यथा यावर टिका केली. शिका संघटित व्हा आणि संघर्ष करा. असा महान संदेश दिला. म.फुले यांनी दलितांसाठी पिण्याचा पाण्याचा हौद रिकामा करून दिला. म.फुले यांचे समग्र साहित्य हे दलित साहित्यासाठी पोषक ठरली. संत घोखामेळा यांनी आपल्या अभंगामधून आपल्यावर होणा-या अन्यायाची वाचा फोडली.

दलित साहित्यामध्ये अन्यायाची घिड आहे. आक्रोश, व्यथा, वेदना आहेत. म्हणून माणसांशी कसा क्रूरपणे वागत आला या भारतीय संस्कृतीने दलित जनास कसे हालहाल करून सोडले यांचे चित्रण आहे. अपमान, अन्याय याचे चित्रण दलित साहित्य करते. भारतीय संस्कृती, अनिष्ट प्रथा, जातीभेद यावर दलित साहित्य भाष्य करते.

दलित साहित्याचे वेगळेपण सांगताना कवितांची निर्मिती जास्त प्रमाणात झाली. दलित कविता निर्भिड आणि परखड आहे. नामदेव ढसाळ, यशवंत मनोहर, केशव मैश्राम हे दलित कवी आहेत. स्त्रीवर अन्याय होत असल्याची वाचा हिसा बनसोडे, ज्योती लाजेवार, प्रज्ञा लोखंडे यांनी केली. लोकभाषा, म्हणी, वाक्यप्रचार प्रतिमा इ. मुळे दलित कवितेचे वेगळेपण दिसते. दलित कादंबरीचा विचार करता अण्णाभाऊ साठे हे दलित साहित्यातील पहिले कादंबरीकार होत. त्यांच्या नंतर शंकरराव खरात यांनी दिर्घकाळ मोठ्या प्रमाणात कादंबरी लेखन केले.

दलित साहित्याने 1960 नंतर मराठी साहित्य सारस्वत समृद्ध केले. दलित साहित्य परिवर्तनवादी आहे. दलित साहित्य आधुनिक सुधारणावादाचा पुरस्कार करते. समता, शांती, विश्वबंधुत्व, न्याय ह्या विचारांचा पुरस्कार करते. दलित साहित्याने अन्याय, अत्याचार, गुलामगिरी, भेदाभेद, वर्णवर्चस्व यांवर कडकडून टीका केली. पिडीत, शोषित, अन्यायग्रस्त श्रमिक कष्टक-यांचे वर्षानुवर्षे लादलेल्या गुलामगिरीचे चित्रण आहे.

दलित साहित्याचा नायक सामान्य माणूस आहे. दलित साहित्यातील कथा, कादंबरी, कविता, आत्मकथन, नाटक इ साहित्य प्रकाराचा अभ्यास करताना आंबेडकर विचारांचे पाठबळ असणे आवश्यक ठरते मुंबई विद्यापीठाने पदवी मराठी अभ्यासक्रमात दलित साहित्य प्रवाहाचे ज्ञान प्राप्त करून देणा-या अभ्यासक्रमाची योजना केली आहे. विद्यार्थ्यांबाबतच्या कर्तव्य व उद्दिष्टांची पूर्ती करण्याच्या प्रयत्नातून आम्ही हे एकदिवसीय राज्यस्तरीय चर्चासत्र घेतले आहे.



REPORT

SUMMARY

A seminar on Environment Management & Biodiversity Conservation organized by department of Botany, Zoology and Chemistry of Abasaheb Marathe College from 17th -18th of January, 2014 was held at Rajapur, District Ratnagiri (Maharashtra). The seminar invited papers on the mentioned theme from interested participants of various organizations belonging to any part of the country. The seminar also included college presentations from Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. There was an active participation, particularly from local academicians and students of Maharashtra.

The two day seminar included paper presentations, discussions, suggestions & recommendations. The seminar was an attempt to bring out the significance of environment and their management, biodiversity and their conservation and mitigate the effects of environment issues by Green Chemistry.

INTRODUCTION

Abasaheb Marathe College organized the seminar on Environment Management & Biodiversity Conservation with the sole objective of spreading awareness and motivating people especially youth to help save our environment. The seminar highlighted the significance of these issues whose relevance in today's

world is highly substantial. The link between environmental changes and biodiversity loss has long been established. Although throughout Earth's history the environment has always changed with ecosystems and it takes huge burden on every species, due to this species coming and going. Rapid environment change affects ecosystems and those species could not able to adapt and so biodiversity loss increases. Environment change is projected to affect all aspects of biodiversity. Changes in biodiversity at ecosystem and landscape scale, in response to environment change and the greediness of human being on natural resources would further affect on global and regional biodiversity. From a human perspective, the rapid environment change accelerating biodiversity loss risks human security. It can bring about a major change in the food chain upon which we depend, water sources may change, recede or disappear, medicines and other resources we rely on may be harder to obtain. There is a dire need to conserve water bodies and our rare species which are already on the verge of extinction. The impact of environment change needs to be tackled effectively and conducting such seminars could be a primary step towards attaining this goal.

ISSUES COVERED

The seminar focused on two broad and seven sub-categories related to environment namely:-

- ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT
- BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION
 - ❖ Environmental Issues & Pollution
 - ❖ Environmental Policies, Act's and Regulations
 - ❖ Sustainable Development
 - ❖ Natural Resources and their management

- ❖ Climate Change Impact on Natural Resources and Biodiversity
- ❖ Environmentally Benign Chemistry: Green Chemistry
- ❖ Biodiversity and its conservation

As 2010 is being celebrated as the International Year of Biodiversity, it is our responsibility to reduce the current rate of biodiversity loss at the global, regional and national level. Biodiversity losses has serious economic and social costs for any country. The poor countries will be worst affected as the interdependence between men and environment in these societies is very significant and any imbalance in the ecosystem may shock the very survival of these people. The international community has recognized biodiversity's important role in supporting human life, which led to the 1992 founding of the Convention on Biological Diversity, a legally binding global treaty.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR

DAY 1: JANUARY 17, 2014

The two-day Seminar started with the registration. After the registration, the session began with inaugural addressed by Dr. T. G. Jagtap and Shridharrao Rane. The inaugural address included the relevance of issues related to environment and their increasing threats. In an era of rapid industrialization and urbanization men has conveniently ignored the element of environment. Marine ecosystem is mostly affected by human interference. Both the dignitaries brought forward the significance of holding such Seminars as they fulfill

the primary aim of sensitizing individuals and encouraging their participation.

It was followed by the key note address of Dr. T. G. Jagtap on "Ecologically sensitive marine ecosystems from tropical and subtropical regions. It was followed by plenary session of the participant's oral paper presentation. In the afternoon the second plenary session was started with the invited talk by Dr. Varad Giri on "Study

on the ecology and natural history of some endemic Amphibians and Reptiles of the Northern Western Ghats". It was followed by participant's oral paper presentation. Dr. Santosh Kamble, Convenor of EMABC-14 was open



the ideas behind organizing this seminar and also discusses the objectives of environment management and biodiversity conservation theme. Extending a warm welcome to the participants, Principal Dr. D. D. Kurlapkar thanked them for sparing their valuable time and commitment to strengthen such vital issues of environmental concerns.

DAY 2: JANUARY 18, 2014

This day was commenced with installation of participant's poster Paper



Presentations. The session however begins with invited talk by Smt. (Dr.) Niranjana Chavan's presentation on Mangrove Ecosystem. She briefed the participants about the present status and conservation measures for mangrove ecosystem of west coast of India. She discussed the activities and field investigations done on the above mentioned issue by

students Kolhapur school. It was followed by participant's oral paper presentations.

The last session is reserved for green chemistry. Dr. Sandip Sankpal was made attention on uses of green chemistry in the present situation for protection environment. It was again followed by participant's oral paper presentations.



The presentation was very resourceful and inspiring especially for the students, researchers and teachers present in the Seminar.

CONCLUDING REMARKS

Dr. Shendage, organizing secretary, while concluding said that the issues discussed at the Seminar were of global concern and do not deserve to be neglected. He emphasized on people's participation towards attaining a common goal of conserving the environment. Biodiversity and wetlands form two pillars of our environment and any disturbance caused leads to harmful outcomes. Climate change which is a byproduct of this disturbance hence needs to be tackled effectively. He on the behalf of EMABC-14 thanked all the participants for their active participation and interests concerning such a vital issue.



At the end of the seminar, ideas were exchanged by the participants and each one expressed their views and concerns of environment management and biodiversity conservation and suggested certain guidelines to be followed in general.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF RAJAPUR SEMINAR

1. Awareness should be generated about the harmful consequences of human pressure on the biodiversity.
2. Improve people's participation for conservation of nature and natural resources.
3. Engage youths in action as they are the future of our country.
4. Decision makers should be provided orientation training on the topics like environment, biodiversity and conservation of natural resources.
5. Regional, national and international co-operation should be promoted for the exchange of information on the issues related to biodiversity.
6. Problem solving and action oriented case studies on present status of biodiversity and their conservation measures, should be taken up and instructional materials on this should be prepared
7. Conducting seminars on a more regular basis as they act as a motivator in encouraging the local population.


Brief Report of the National Conference

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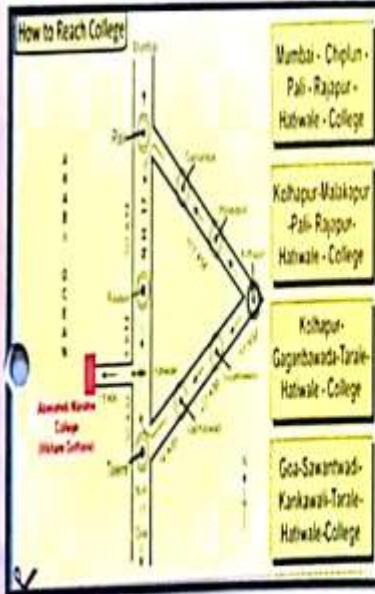

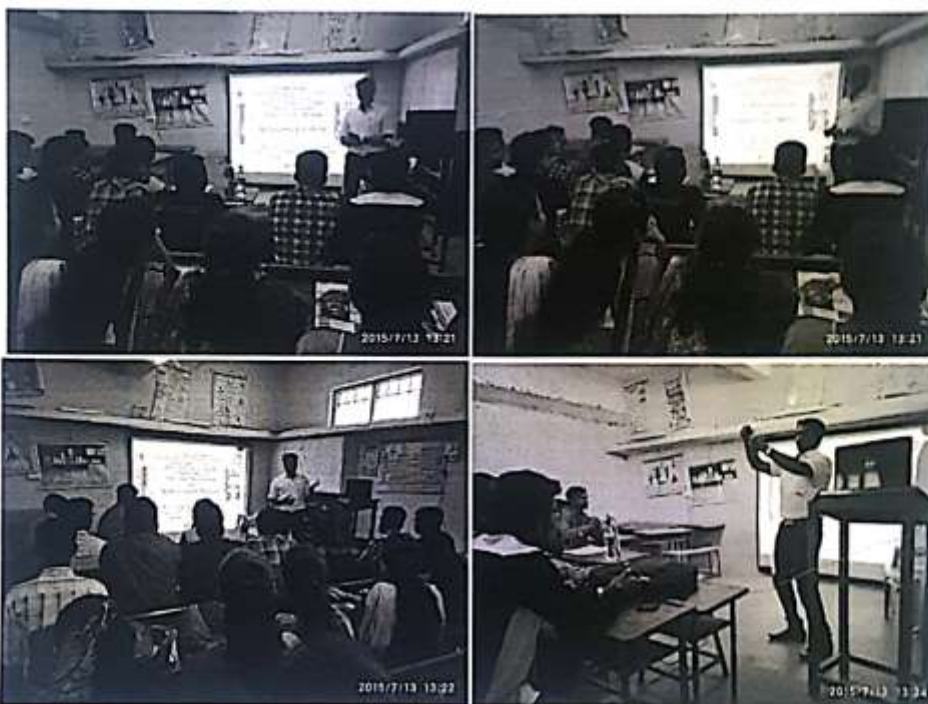

Prof. Savant Kamalakar from Lanja College, Prof. Shevale Sachin from Devgad College, guided the participants as the resource persons on the topic respectively.



About Western Ghats, Konkan region and Biodiversity Conservation :

Western Ghats is one of the eight "hottest hot-spots" of biodiversity in the world. It runs approximately 1600 km through the state of Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Kerala. Recently UNESCO (The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization) has declared 39 places as World Heritage Sites in Western Ghats; out of 39 places, four are found in Maharashtra, i.e. Chandoli National Park, Kaas Plateau, Koyna wildlife sanctuary and Radhanagri wildlife sanctuary.

Konkan is prosperous for plant diversity as well as beauty of Maharashtra. It is a narrow coastal strip to the west of Sahyadri and about 800 km in length from Goa to Maharashtra. As far as biodiversity point of view is concern, Konkan is one of important areas in Maharashtra.

Western Ghats is under huge human pressure and numbers of species are rare, endangered and threatened (RET). In recent years, increasing loss of biodiversity has created serious threats to the survival of mankind. The main causes of biodiversity loss are habitat destruction, pollution, population, invasive weed, over exploitation and climate change.

Destruction of the habitat is the major threat of biodiversity. Endemism is the ecological state of a species being unique to a defined geographic location, such as an island, nation, country or other defined zone.

Therefore, it has become necessary to conserve endemic and threatened plants of the Konkan & Western Ghats region of Maharashtra.

The main goal of this workshop is to develop awareness among students and teachers about biodiversity of Western Ghats and Konkan region of Maharashtra and conservation measures for endemic and rare plants.




