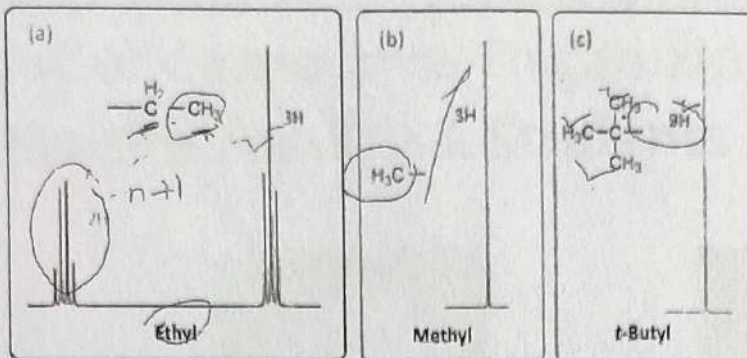

**Description about the Program-**


